his attendants nor the people who were left in the land  
listened to what the LORD said through Jeremiah.  
Nevertheless, King Zedekiah sent Jehucal son of Shelemiah,  
and Zephaniah the priest, son of Maaseiah, to ask Jeremiah,  
'Please pray to the LORD our God for us' Jeremiah has not  
yet been imprisoned, so he could come and go among the  
people as he pleased. At this time the army of Pharaoh  
Hophra of Egypt appeared at the southern border of Judah.  
When the Babylonian army heard of it they withdrew from  
their siege of Jerusalem. Then the LORD gave this message  
to Jeremiah, 'This is what the LORD, the God of Israel says,  
the King of Judah sent you to ask me what is going to  
happen. Tell him Pharaoh's army is about to return to Egypt,  
though he came here to help you. Then the Babylonians will  
come back capture this city and burn it to the ground.'
