In the original Hebrew, the scroll of Ezra-Nehemiah was part of a large historical work, the first part which was 1 & 2 Chronicles. The whole work is governed by the same theological point of view, is written in the same style and displays such an overall unity that it undoubtedly came from the hand of the same author.. Known as the "Chronicler" his identity is unknown. He must have been a member of the Temple staff, possibly one of the Levites..		
The concluding verses of 2 Chronicles are identical with the opening verses of Ezra; this was a scribes way of connecting the narrative and saying that the Chronicles and Ezra-Nehemiah are actually one book.
