A Personal Note:

Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord. And the prayer of faith will save the one who is sick, and the Lord will raise him up. And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven. James 5: 14-15

This week I observed my father being anointed by our Pastor and Head Elder. This verse explains why. It was interesting to see that first you must be sick but you must also have faith (like the father in Mark 9: 14—27 I say "I believe; help my unbelief!"). It also says that sins will be forgiven. The anointing process isn't just about the physical healing but spiritual as well. I think this makes so much sense as even though we pray for physical healing specifically, God sometimes doesn't heal the physical ailment, but God *ALWAYS* heals the spiritual ailment if we ask.
